# Learning modules

## Module 1

### **PE Outdoor adventure team challenge and problem-solving**

Faced with both individual and teamwork challenges, the children will endeavour to cross crocodile swamps and minefields, crawl through a giant spider's web, shoot a longbow, go sheep rafting, learn to walk the plank (without drowning) and take on the great photo-orienteering challenge.

These non-hazardous challenges (we don't use real crocodiles!) are designed to fulfil the Outdoor and Adventure Activities section of the KS2 curriculum. The activities are non-competitive and emphasis is on the children appraising their own and their team performance through their Team Diary.

All specialist equipment is provided and the activities are suitable for SEN children and those with specialised mobility needs.
