Learning modules

Module 1

Ice Breakers

A range of fun games designed to introduce the children to the themes of teamwork, cooperation and problem solving.

Module 2

Problem solving challenges

- Toxic Minefield- Teams attempt to save a family of helpless ducks from a toxic minefield.
- Crate Challenge- Teams use crates, planks of wood and a rope to carry jugs of water across a piranha infested swamp.
- Marble Challenge- Teams must transport a radioactive ball through an obstacle course using pipes.
- Scrap heap challenge- Teams use scrap materials to build a tower that is strong enough to hold an apple off the ground for 1 minute.
- The Egg Launch Rocket Challenge- an exciting and entertaining adaptation of the traditional 'egg drop'.

Module 3

Team challenges

A range of fun team building and trust building activities and games, including:

- The Water Pipe Game- The aim of this game is to fill a bucket with as much water as possible in a given time frame. But it is not as easy as it sounds, when the equipment supplied to do it includes a helmet with a jug attached to it and long pipes with holes in them!
- Team Skiing- Teams must race each other on our 5-person skis.
- Capture The Flag- A strategic combat style game where teams must work together to protect their flag, and try to penetrate the other teams' defences.

Module 4

Orienteering

Following a brief introduction talk (covering the countryside code, health and safety tips and familiarisation with Ilam Hall's orienteering map) teams will set off into Ilam Park to test their skills on our very own British Orienteering Federation standard course.

Module 5

Circus skills

Children learn new skills such as juggling and Maori Poi spinning.

- Eco Warrior Award- This activity encourages young people to understand more about the importance of their impact upon the environment.
- Eco- Art- Participants use materials found in the grounds to create a large piece of artwork with an environmental theme.
- Reusable Shopping Bags- Participants decorate cloth reusable shopping bags with an environmental slogan and design.
